1. What is this product about?

This is an individual travel insurance covering travelers departing from Malaysia. Benefits include Personal Accident, Accidental & Sickness Medical expenses, Repatriation expenses due to accident and Travel Inconvenience benefits such as flight delay, loss of travel documents, damage to luggage and etc.

2. What are the covers / benefits provided?

Please refer to the Summary of Benefits for the complete list of benefits included for One Way Plan and Return Plan respectively.

Destination country covered includes Malaysia, Singapore, Thailand, Indonesia, Laos, Cambodia, Vietnam, China (excluding Tibet & Mongolia), Hong Kong, Macau, Taiwan, Philippines, Japan, South Korea, Brunei and Myanmar.

3. How much premium do I have to pay?

Premium is RM7.00 for One Way Plan.
Premium for Return Plan starts from RM13.00 for 1 to 10 days, each additional week is RM 7.00.
Payment of premium is acceptable using credit card only.

4. What are the fees and charges I have to pay?

No commission or stamp duty is charged.

5. What are some of the key terms and conditions that I should be aware of?

- Importance of disclosure :
Pursuant to Paragraph 5 of Schedule 9 of the Financial Services Act 2013, if you are applying for this Insurance wholly for purposes unrelated to your trade, business or profession, you have a duty to take reasonable care not to make a misrepresentation in answering the questions in the Proposal Form (or when you apply for this insurance). You must answer the questions fully and accurately.

Failure to take reasonable care in answering the questions may result in avoidance of your contract of insurance, refusal or reduction of your claim(s), change of terms or termination of your contract of insurance.

The above duty of disclosure shall continue until the time your contract of insurance is entered into, varied or renewed with us.

In addition to answering the questions in the Proposal Form (or when you apply for this insurance), you are required to disclose any other matter that you know to be relevant to our decision in accepting the risks and determining the rates and terms to be applied.

You also have a duty to tell us immediately if at any time after your contract of insurance has been entered into, varied or renewed with us any of the information given in the Proposal Form (or when you applied for this insurance) is inaccurate or has changed.

You must observe and fulfill the Terms, Conditions, Endorsements, Clauses or Warranties of the Policy.

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- Age eligible to purchase: 2 to 75 years old (calculated based on travel date).
- Claims: To be notified within 1 month from date of loss/incident and submission of documents within 1 year from date of loss/incident.
- Period of insurance: Up to 60 days for Return Plan & up to destination (to countries stated above) for One Way Plan.
- Duplication of cover for Medical Claims: Prorate according to total sum insured of this policy plus insured's medical insurance policy. Original receipts must be submitted.
- Policy Excess: Baggage Damage & Loss of Personal Effects benefit and Accidental Medical Expenses benefit are subject to RM50.00 policy excess.
- Goods & Services Tax : You agree to pay us for any taxes or government charges imposed by the government with respect of the execution or delivery of this policy.

6. What are the major exclusions under this policy?

This insurance does not cover:-

- a) Self-inflicted injury or suicide
- b) Mental disorders
- c) Pre-existing condition where you are aware of your medical condition and requires treatment from medical practitioner
- d) Pregnancy and/or miscarriage
- e) War
- f) Epidemic or pandemic declared by World Health Organisation
- g) Terrorism or terrorist attacks
- h) Riots, Strikes and other similar movements causing political unrest
- i) Natural catastrophes
- j) Mountaineering activities, scuba diving, paragliding, sky diving, motor vehicle racing and other similar sports

7. Can I cancel my policy?

Yes. You may cancel your policy and request for a refund of premium before the commencement of your departure date.
